Dear Parents,

I am delighted to share with you our clubs and activities programme for the Summer Term. Please use the contents links below to find each relevant section. 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For those of you new to clubs and activities, it is relatively straightforward. **Pre-Prep children** (Reception-Year 2) have a range of clubs they can join, taking place during and after the school day. Some of these clubs allow the children to simply turn up and join in, while others need to be booked by parents. You can see what is on offer to Pre-Prep children [by clicking here](#).

In the Prep School, on Mondays during lesson 6, all of the Year 3-6 children participate in a carousel of enrichment activities which began in September 2022. The children do this in their year group houses. After 6-7 sessions, they swap to a new activity. These activities are fixed, in that each child will get to sample and enjoy all of those on offer to their year group. You can see what your child will be doing [by clicking here](#).

On **Wednesdays during lesson 6**, the Year 3-6 children are allowed to choose from a [wide range of activities](#). You will notice the choices available are specific to certain year groups, but we aim to change what is on offer to the children on a regular basis and encourage all children to try something new. Please note numbers are limited, so we ask children to choose a top three. We will give each child one of these choices and if your child does not get their first choice this term, we will endeavour to give them their first choice the following term.

Finally you will find our extensive **Before School, Lunchtime and After School Clubs programme** [by clicking here](#). Many taking place during the school day are open to all, with children invited to just turn up. Some clubs are by invitation only, while those in yellow occur after school and have to be booked via the booking form. Children in lunchtime clubs will go to first lunch or late lunch, depending on the time of the club. After school clubs may have limited numbers and as with activities, we will endeavour to give children their choice where possible. The allocation of clubs and activities is not based on a 'first come, first served' basis. All requests that are received are cross-referenced against previous allocations to ensure equality of opportunity and access across the year for each child. If a club is over-subscribed though, we will look to ensure they get their choices the following term where possible. Any clubs costs will appear on your end of term 'extras' bill.

All before, during and after school clubs begin in the week commencing Monday 24th April 2023.

Lesson 6 carousel activities and Wednesday activities begin that week too. There are no clubs on the following dates: Mon 1/5 (Bank Holiday), Mon 8/5 (Bank Holiday), Fri 26/5 (school closed), Fri 23/6 (Summer Fair), Tue 27/6 (Open Afternoon). All clubs and activities end for the term by Friday 30th June.

Please spend some time with your child(ren) going through the clubs and activities on offer, then [complete the booking form](#). **All parents of children in Years 3-6 must complete the form.** The deadline is **9am on Tuesday 21st March** and I aim to confirm clubs and activities with you during that week.
