What a wonderful week we have had in Nursery! The children have been listening to lots of stories, singing Nursery Rhymes and exploring the indoor and outdoor environment.




Poppies

Important - New Parents Portal Release

We have recently switched to a new management information system called iSAMS. As part of this transition, the Parent Portal that you will have previously accessed via the Yarm MIS (if your child was in the School last year and previously), will no longer be used. Instead, we will be using the iSAMS Parent Portal going forward which will enable you to view remotely the academic information relating to your child via a secure login.

In addition to school reports, the portal will enable you to view the core information held on our system relating to your contact details, making it easier for you to update this important information as and when it alters. For obvious reasons, it is important that we hold accurate and up to date information regarding your child and it is essential that you provide a valid mobile telephone number and email address as a point of contact **for each contact**.

A shared email can't be used on the new system, therefore please email a second email address and for a respective contact to Pre-Prep georgina.banham@yarmschool.org or Prep louise.white@yarmschool.org.

- Reception to Year 6 Autumn Term Reports released to the Parent Portal **Monday 5th December 4pm**

You will not be sent paper copies of reports so it is important that you have completed the portal registration and login process **prior** to the report release date to try and prevent any delay in report availability. Please keep the log in details in a safe place for future reference.
