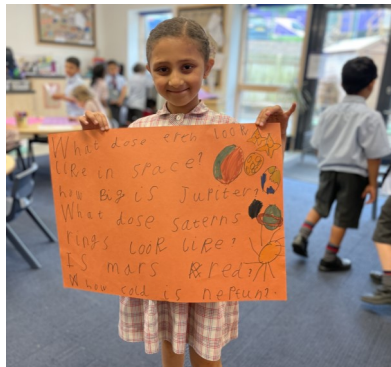

The messy play area in Nursery has been a hive of activity. The children have been channelling their inner artist with paints, sequins and recycled materials.



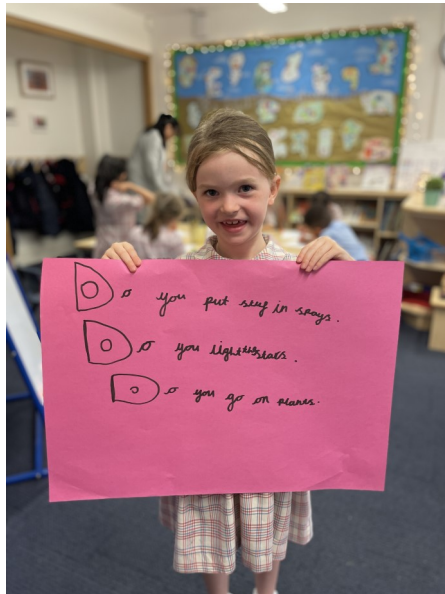
RSPB Saltholme
