Mrs Speight's message ...



Capital Development Update

We returned from the summer break to see the evident progress of our Prep Development project over the summer. This new facility will deliver first rate accommodation which will include a new performance venue, library and flexible learning facilities, kitchens and dining space, alongside three classrooms and a reception area.

As you can see from the photos a great deal has been achieved in recent weeks. The target date for completion of the build and being able to use the new facility remains the second half of this term. We are pushing hard to make this a reality but will not be able to adopt the building until such time that it is safe and ready to do so.
